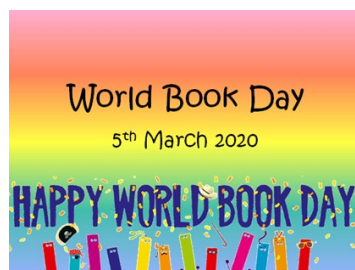
### Tea with the Easter Bunny

Don't forget that we are celebrating World Book Day on Thursday 5th March when your child can come to school dressed as their favourite character from a book.



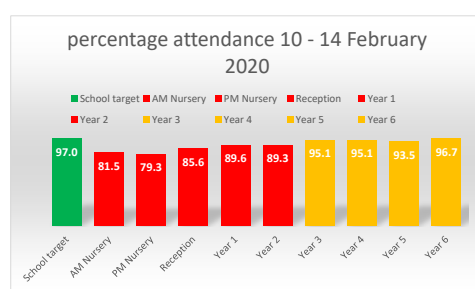
## Year Group Topics
