Please remember school finishes at **2.45pm**. For real emergencies and for those parents who work and as a result are unable to collect their child until 3.20pm, we provide supervision cover.

Recently however we have an increasing number of children who stay behind after 2.45pm simply because parents are picking up late. Unfortunately we cannot accommodate these extra children. Please ensure you are in the school yard ready to collect your child at the end of the school day no later than 2.45pm.

We would also like to remind parents that it is not acceptable to collect your child early from school. Please arrange dentist, haircuts etc for after school - there is no need for any child to leave before 2.45pm unless they have a medical appointment - please bring proof of this if you ever need to collect your child early.

To clarify, school finishes at 2.45pm. Children must not be taken earlier than this time and must be picked up on time. The only children allowed to stay until 3.20pm are those whose parents are working and unable to collect until 3.20pm or in an emergency situation.

Year 4


Year 4 would like to invite their parents in to their celebration afternoon for their topic: Gods and Mortals on Wednesday 1st April at 1:45 pm
